Established in 2001, the Barnett Searing National Cancer Foundation (BSNCF) was born out of the shared experiences of John Searing and Kevin Barnett, who tragically lost their loved ones, Jenny Searing and Mary Barnett, to cancer. Jenny, diagnosed with ovarian sarcoma, passed away at the young age of 26, while Mary battled uterine sarcoma until her passing at 55. Driven by their passionate desire to honor their memory and help other families, John and Kevin joined forces to create the Barnett-Searing National Cancer Foundation as a beacon of hope and support for cancer patients and their families.

BSNCF has a rich history of initiatives that have made a meaningful impact in the lives of those affected by cancer. Our current "Smile Kit" program aims to bring comfort and uplift the spirits of cancer patients.

Throughout the years, BSNCF has expanded its reach and impact through collaborations with renowned cancer research institutions such as the Dana Farber Cancer Institute and Anderson Cancer Center Research.



The Foundation has also implemented various programs and projects, including financial assistance, caregiver workshops, patient navigator systems, and partnerships with organizations like Lee's Friends. PROGRESS REPORT

In 2022, the Barnett-Searing National Cancer Foundation (BSNCF) achieved a significant milestone by gifting over 1000 "Smile Kits" to cancer patients in a single calendar year bringing our total number of "Smile Kits" delivered to over 3,800. These thoughtfully curated kits contain a selection of comforting items, such as cozy blankets, soothing lip balm, adult books, and handmade coloring inspirational cards. The purpose of these "Smile Kits" is to provide a moment of respite, promoting self-care, relaxation, and emotional well-being during the challenging journey of cancer treatment. Through the distribution of each "Smile Kit," BSNCF aims to bring a smile to the faces of cancer patients and remind them that they are supported and loved throughout their battle.

Sending Smiles Across the Miles

This goal was made possible by the donations from the community, the Daybreak Rotary Club and members of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in Leesburg, Virginia. The clubs were able to assemble 758 Smile Kits for the Barnett - Searing National Cancer Foundation at Loudoun County High School on December 10, 2022. The accomplishment was recognized in a commendation resolution which will go into the journal of the Virginia General Assembly presented Delegate Reid. 758 "Smile Kits" created really means that 3000 lives minimally were touched. recipient likely has a partner or spouse and perhaps children. 
