The Barnett-Searing National Cancer Foundation (BSNCF) was founded in 2001 to honor two courageous women and carry on their legacy through philanthropy.

Mary Barnett was a devoted teacher and mother. She inspired her students with her love of learning and positivity. Her family was the most important thing in her life. Mary bravely fought uterine sarcoma and passed away in 2002, at age 55. Jennifer Searing was known for her kindness, warmth and contagious laugh. Always offering a smile, words of encouragement, or a spirit of service, she made a lasting impact on everyone she met. In 1995, Jenny passed away from ovarian sarcoma at the age of 26.


Brett Fox

Since 2023, Kara has been the web designer for BSNCF, helping to boost its online presence and share its mission in a meaningful way.



BSNCF Smile Kits are carefully curated care packages filled with items to bring comfort and joy to women battling cancer. This year, we delivered Smile Kits to cancer respite centers and chemo clinics, providing comfort when women need it most. Additionally, we mailed Smile Kits to 185 cancer heroes nominated by loved ones.
